Centerline Sport Horses

This Breeding Contract, for the breeding season of 20__, is made and entered into on this _____ day of _____, 20__, and is by and between Colette Sossaman of Centerline Sport Horses hereinafter designated as "Breeder" and _____, hereinafter designated as "Mare Owner". Mare Owner agrees to breed the mare, known as _____, hereinafter designated as "Mare" to the Andalusian stallion, Jovial D, hereinafter designated as "Stallion" for the breeding fee of \$_____. This breeding will be subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. The \$_____ breeding fee includes a non-refundable booking fee of \$_____. The full breeding fee of \$_____ is due upon execution of this Contract.
2. Shipping procedures listed in Appendix A of this contract should be followed.
3. The Mare Owner will advise the Breeder at the start of the mare's cycle and will contact the Breeder again on the day prior to the desired collection and shipment. The Breeder cannot guarantee shipment on the desired date without this information. Centerline Sport Horses will make every effort to accommodate your collection needs, even at the last minute; however, there may be an extra charge of \$50 for less than 24-hour notice for collection.
4. Also, Centerline Sport Horses agrees with the theory (supported by the Colorado State Course on Artificial Insemination and Cooled Shipments) that stallions collected daily are at risk of a drop in concentration and motility and suggest collecting every other day at most. Therefore, in order to accommodate other requests for shipment, Centerline Sport Horses has agreed that a schedule of Monday, Wednesday and Friday for collection will best meet the needs of all involved without compromising the quality and quantity of semen available.
5. It would be best if the Mare Owner has the Mare checked for pregnancy at approximately 16 days after ovulation. This allows time for any problems that could arise from possible twin embryos and will also allow time to prepare for the next breeding cycle if the Mare has not settled.
6. The Mare will need to be checked again by a licensed veterinarian for pregnancy at roughly 45 days after the last date of breeding. The Mare Owner will need then to forward these results signed by the examining veterinarian, to the Breeder within 15 days of the examination. Failure to do so may render the live foal guarantee null and void.

7. The Mare Owner agrees that only the Mare named in this Contract will be inseminated with semen collected from the Stallion named in this Contract. This breeding is non-transferable.
8. The Mare will be healthy and in sound breeding condition. A veterinarian health certificate and uterine culture are highly recommended prior to the shipment of semen from the Breeder. If the Mare fails to settle in foal after two cycles, Breeder may require Mare Owner to obtain a current reproductive exam/uterine culture prior to any further shipments.
9. The charge for additional shipments under this Contract will be \$200 for each shipment.
10. This contract contains a "live-foal guarantee". A live-foal is defined as a newborn foal that stands and nurses with minimal assistance. If the Mare does not deliver a live foal (resulting from the death or absence of the foal), as defined herein, the Mare Owner will receive a return breeding privilege for the year 20__ breeding season, on the condition that the Breeder is notified within 30 days of the loss and receives a licensed veterinarian's statement confirming death. If, after being pronounced safe in foal, the Mare should miscarry, abort, or prove barren, Mare Owner has the privilege to request additional semen shipments during the breeding season (February 1, 20__ through October 31, 20__), or the following breeding season.
11. A Breeder's Certificate will be sent by separate post, immediately following shipment of the semen.
12. If the Mare fails to settle for any reason, the Mare Owner will hold the Breeder blameless.
13. It is further agreed that if the Stallion should die or be declared impotent by a licensed veterinarian before the Mare settles (with maximum time limit of October 21, 20__), any fees paid, less expenses, will be refunded to the Mare Owner, thereby canceling the breeding contract.
14. Breeding season commences February 1, 20__ and ends October 31, 20__, unless extended by mutual agreement between Mare Owner and Breeder.
15. This contract is entered into in the State of Texas, County of Dallas, and will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of this state. If any clause in the contract is against state law, then that clause shall be null and void. All other terms and conditions will remain in effect.

If containers are not returned within this time frame, you will be charged a replacement cost, and we will be unable to accommodate additional shipment requests until the container is returned/replaced

Please ship via **UPS Two-Day Service**. We ask that you insure the container for \$250 in case the container is lost or damaged en-route.

Appendix B: Procedures for breedings for IALHA registerable foals

1. Upon paying the breeding fee in full and included in with the first semen shipment, the Mare Owner will receive a signed Application for IALHA - Bred Purebred Horse or Application for IALHA - Bred Half -Andalusian Horse (appropriate form name would appear on contract based on mare the agreement is for) for registration of the resulting foal, by the Mare Owner, with the International Andalusian and Lusitano Horse Association (IALHA).
2. It is also agreed that a copy of the stallions Certificado de Inscripcion y Carta Genealogica from the Ministerio de Defensa Jefatura de Criar Caballar certifying Jovial D has been approved and included into the Spanish Stud Book as a Pura Raza Espanola breeding stallion be provided to the Mare Owner along with the first semen shipment.
3. It is also agreed that at the end of 20__, in accordance with the deadlines established by the respective organizations, the Stallion Manager/Agent/Owner will complete and forward to the appropriate parties the following reports: IALHA Half-Andalusian Stallion Report, IALHA Purebred Andalusian Stallion Report, Estado Annual de Altas de Ganaderia (report of horses you have bred), and Certificado de Cubricio (report of PRE mares covered in 20__ w/ one certificate per mare) to The Federation of Association Breeders of the P.R.E. in the United States. Completion of these last two reports may require the Stallion Manager/Agent/Owner register his/her breeding farm with the CRIA, obtain a Codigo or breeders number and also file a Estado Annual de Bajas de Ganaderia report.
4. The Mare Owner reserves the right to either obtain a full refund of the 20__ breeding fee or breed the designated mare to Jovial D during the breeding season of 20__, for same 20__ stud fee, should the mare become so ill or incapacitated due to an injury or disease during the 20__ breeding season that it would be unhealthy for the mare and counter productive for the Mare Owner to try and proceed with said 20__ breeding. The Mare Owner would provide the Stallion Manager/Agent/Owner with a veterinarians certificate stating the cause of such illness/injury.
5. The Stallion Manager/Agent/Owner assumes the responsibility for certifying the stallion's motility and total count, and providing the Mare Owner with a certified copy of said motility by a qualified veterinarian, dated on the collection day for the designated mare under this agreement. The Mare Owner shall have the right to check said motility by a qualified veterinarian prior to use upon receipt of the shipment. If said motility rate is below one hundred million live, progressively motile, morphologically normal spermatozoa, in a total volume of no more than 40 cc, then the Mare Owner shall immediately notify the Stallion Manager/Agent/Owner and shall have the right to reject said shipment and obtain

second shipment, at no additional costs to the Mare Owner, subject to same testing and rejection conditions. Should the second shipment fail testing conditions as well the Mare Owner once again shall have the right to reject the shipment and the agreement with a refund of the purchase price less booking fee paid to back to the Mare Owner.

6. Risk of loss or damage of any shipment sent to the Mare Owner shall be on the Stallion Manager/Agent/Owner and risk of loss shall not accrue to the Mare Owner until Mare Owner has taken possession of said shipment.
